



## Appliqué





Create beautiful appliqué patterns from your embroideries.


















- Insert appliqué fabric outlines into an existing design with appliqué areas
- Preview your appliqués on screen using different fabrics
- Export the appliqué pieces to your cutting machine

	<p>Open a blank canvas and choose the 120x120mm Hoop, Orientation Natural.</p>	
	<p>Go to the SuperDesign tab and find Shapes 1, Applique</p>	

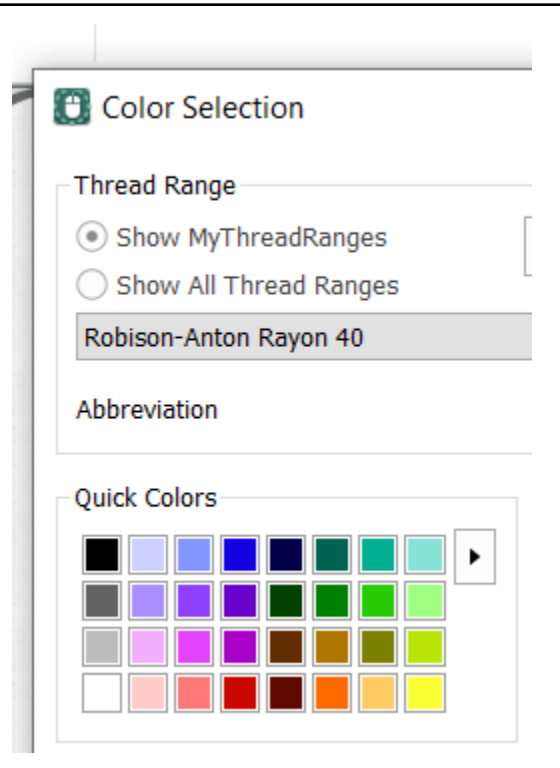
	<p>Choose the cross design and set the size to 80mm. Click Apply</p>	
	<p>Right click to Fix the SuperDesign as stitches. This is an important step before adding appliqué lines otherwise the design can not be recognized.</p>	
	<p>Go to the Appliqué Tab. The Appliqué feature will only add the visual of the appliqué, not add any appliqué steps or stitches.</p> <p>Here you have different options. You can create your own Applique outline with either Freehand Line or Point Line. Or choose Express Appliqué.</p>	
	<p>Click Express Appliqué. The Applique areas are automatically selected.</p>	
	<p>A pop-up will open and show different Applique Selections.</p>	

	<p>Click Fabric under Appliqué type.</p>	
	<p>On Fabric Options click Previously loaded fabric.</p>	
	<p>This will open a picture viewer where you have a selection of fabric images to choose from.</p> <p>Choose checkerboard and the black/white swatch.</p> <p>Click OK</p>	
	<p>Click Select Piece and click on the satin edge of the cross</p>	

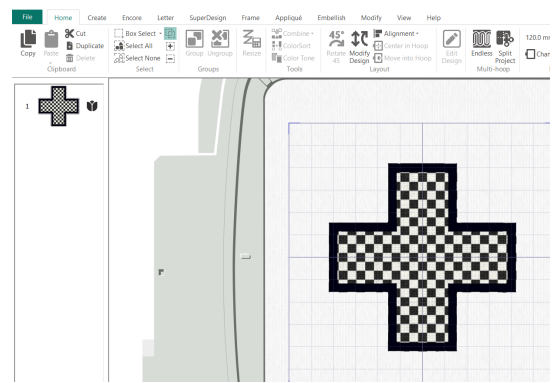
	<p>You can adjust the points if needed. In this design it is only needed to have corner points to get a nice and straight cross.</p> <p>Either you can delete the extra points or use either Freehand Line or Point Line under Applique outline.</p>	
	<p>You can Insert and Delete points</p>	
	<p>Click Select Fabrics</p>	
	<p>Use the checked swatch. Click OK</p>

Use the Quick Colors to change to the almost black color.

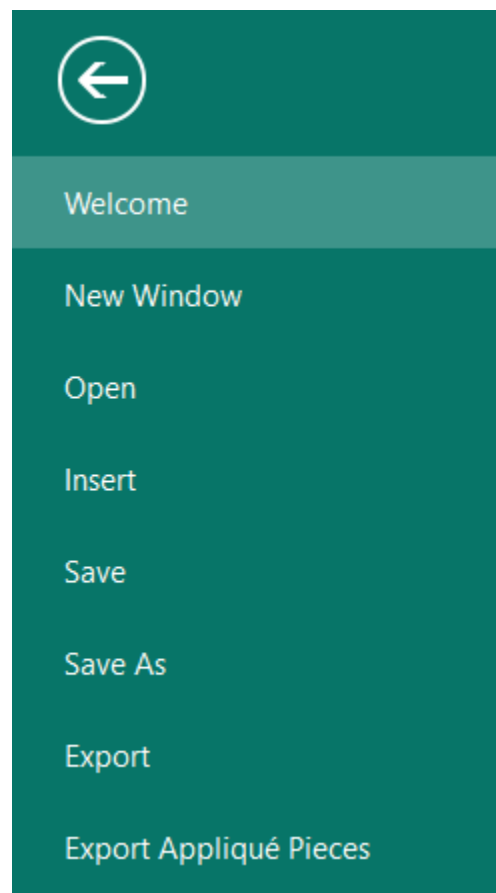

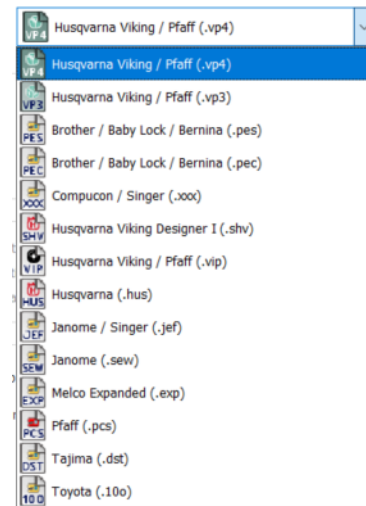


To save the design click on File and Save As. This will save a .vp4 file that is fully editable again if you want to continue working with it.
